## **Power System Status Restoration**

1 Week Since COR4 – ST Sinlaku

### **99% System Load Restoration Achieved**

(Fadian, Mangilao) – The Guam Power Authority (GPA) continues its post-typhoon power restoration process, with 99% system load achieved. Crews will continue to make necessary repairs in the pockets of isolated customers with extensive damages, and close out emergency work clearances requiring customer-side repairs. Customers may report emergency power issues to GPA Dispatch at (671) 475-1472/3/4.

The current peak demand is 240 MW, which has exceeded the targeted peak demand of 234 MW. The peak demand is expected to increase.

As of yesterday, crews were also in the following areas that were affected by damages from heavy vegetation: Bordallo Subdivision (Salas Street), Yigo; Kongga Road (MaiMai), Ordot-Chalan Pago; Balajadia Street, Yona; as well as other heavily vegetated areas in Talo'fo'fo, Inalåhan, and Yona, some of which may have already been restored.

GPA expresses its appreciation to the island community, especially the village mayors and Department of Public Works (DPW) for their assistance to clear heavy vegetation in some villages.

Our priority is to restore energy back into your homes and businesses; and restore the island-wide power system (IWPS) online at full capacity. Si Yu'os Ma'åse' for your patience and support.

**Customers without power service, experiencing power quality issues, or who have completed Emergency Work Clearances are requested to contact GPA at (671) 647-5787/88/89 to report these issues for resolution.**

**GPA Customer Service Call Center is active from 6 a.m. – 8 p.m. daily through Monday, April 27, 2026 to address Typhoon Sinlaku customer concerns. Voicemails and direct messages are checked hourly during regular business hours, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

## TODAY'S KEY OBJECTIVES INCLUDE:

- Crews continue to address isolated typhoon-related power outages affecting approximately 600 customers island-wide (1% of total customers). These individual outages may require transformer change out or line repair, as well as customer-side repairs (e.g. weatherhead, meter socket, etc.).
  - As power lines heat up, weak points of the system will be apparent (*e.g., storm damaged transformers, fuse cutouts, lightning arrestors, connections*). Additionally, hardware components may have been loosened by the typhoon which may fail after power had been restored. Crews will do their best to make immediate repairs; if they cannot, they will return to make the repairs as soon as possible.
- Heavy equipment operators and line crews continue to clear vegetation blocking access to areas needing restoration and repair.
- No one will be left behind. Crews are now working 12-hour shifts, through the day and night, for restoration efforts and will continue to work until all customers have been restored.

## GENERAL NOTIFICATIONS:

- Individuals with medical needs: Those requiring electrically powered life-support or oxygen tanks or similar devices should arrange to stay at an alternate location where electricity is available, such as a hospital or with family or friends who have power restored. Be prepared to bring your oxygen supplies, medical equipment, and medications with you.
- Damaged Weatherheads and other Electrical Components: Customers are advised to conduct their own home and property assessment, including the weatherhead, meter socket and other electrical components. If electrical equipment such as the weatherhead or meter socket was damaged during the storm, it must be repaired before power service can be restored. - Customer generators: Please ensure your main breaker(s) are opened (off position) when operating emergency/standby generators to prevent dangerous working conditions for the GPA line crews.
- Carbon monoxide safety hazard: Carbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless, odorless gas that can cause serious illness or death. The risk increases when generators or fuel-powered equipment are used improperly. Never use generators, grills, or portable stoves indoors. Keep equipment away from doors, windows, and vents, and never run vehicles inside garages. If you feel dizzy, nauseated, or lightheaded, move to fresh air immediately. If you suspect carbon monoxide exposure, call emergency services immediately.
- Voltage fluctuations during restoration: As power is restored, some customers may experience temporary voltage fluctuations such as flickering lights, dimming, or partial power. Customers are advised to shut off their main breaker and report the issue to GPA.
- Please stay away from all down lines and equipment as they may still be energized and can cause harm if you come in contact with the lines or equipment. Consider such situations as dangerous and life threatening. To report downed power lines, contact GPA Trouble Dispatch at (671) 475-1472/1473/1474.
